

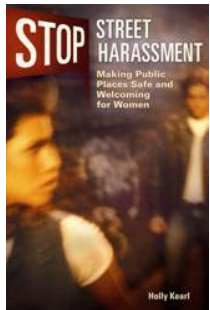

## **Bully Culture: Understanding It and Overcoming It**

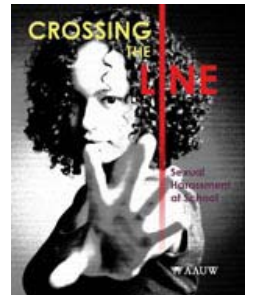

### **Featuring National Speaker: Holly Kearl**



Holly Kearl is the author of the book Stop Street Harassment: Making Public Places Safe and Welcoming for Women. Holly has worked full time for AAUW where she manages programs

that address issues like sexual harassment and assault and workplace discrimination.

Additional presenters include:

**Value U.** is a student-staff collaboration at Clarkson University, partnered with St. Lawrence AAUW, targeting anti-social behavior through bystander intervention by addressing cultural barriers through media literacy. As they like to put it, "Decrease the stupid, increase the fun." Value U. will help participants develop their media literacy regarding the myriad of messages we encounter regarding bullying. Value U. will show participants how to use this literacy in a culturally sensitive way to address social attitudes and behavior that support bullying.

A panel facilitated by the **Victims Assistance Center** and including Jefferson County District Attorney Cindy Intschert as well as law enforcement officers from Jefferson and St. Lawrence Counties will discuss about community response and preventive measures.

Special performance by the **Sackets Harbor Glee Club** led by Joanne Heaslip. The Glee Club is an anti-bullying club that builds confidence and compassion in kids through music.

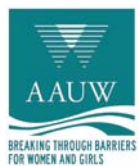
**JCC Student AAUW Organization** members, led by Katie FitzGerald, Adjunct Professor of Philosophy, in collaboration with WPBS will premiere a 30-minute documentary film addressing the issue of sexual harassment in grades 7-12, the theme of a recent AAUW research paper entitled "Crossing the Line".

“Anti-bullying Programming in the Schools: College Students and Community Partners”

**Ann Marie Gardinier Halstead**, Assistant Professor and Co-Chair of St. Lawrence University’s Performance and Communication Arts Department, will discuss anti-bullying programming and her children’s play, *Have You Filled a Bucket Today?*, based on the award-winning children’s book of the same title by Carol McCloud. The adaptation, with its strong anti-bullying message and larger-than-life characters is geared toward elementary school students. The play has had both professional and university productions, and has been submitted to two major publishing houses. Gardinier Halstead will highlight how the arts can help educators, administrators, counselors, and parents to communicate an anti-bullying, and “bucket filling,” philosophy to students of all ages.
